


# WELSH GERMAN EXCHANGE FINAL REPORT


In addition to exploring Wales, the programme was rich with games and activities, fostering friendships and creating lasting memories that the young people will cherish for years to come."






### **STATISTICS**

100% of the young people on the Youth Exchange said that they were able to make new friends through the Exchange





